Criminal act

It is an act prohibited by law as a criminal offence or a fiscal offence or a misdemeanour defined in Articles 51, 69, 74, 76, 85, 87, 119, 122, 124, 133, 143 of the Code of Petty Offences (disturbance of public order, destruction and damage to signs placed by a state authority, damage to signs or devices preventing danger, throwing stones at moving vehicles, arbitrary change of road signs or signals, driving by a person under the influence of alcohol, theft or misappropriation of property, fencing, destruction or damage to property, speculation with admission tickets, hindering the use of devices intended for public use).
