

Demoralization

Violation of generally prevailing social norms, i.e. the so-called social maladjustment, and in particular violation of the principles of social coexistence, committing a prohibited act, systematic evasion of compulsory education or vocational training, use of alcohol or other substances in order to induce intoxication, prostitution, vagrancy, participation in criminal groups

Article 4 § 1 of the Act on proceedings against minors – imposes on anyone who has information about manifestation of demoralization of a juvenile has a social obligation to notify parents or legal guardians, the school, the Family Court or the Police about this fact.
