Incitement

One of the forms of committing a crime. It consists in inciting another person to commit a prohibited act (Article 18 § 2 of the Penal Code). Incitement is always an intentional behaviour, it can only be committed with direct intent, in the form of action (incitement in the form of omission is impossible). Incitement consists in inciting a person individually designated to commit a prohibited act. The penalty for incitement is imposed within the limits provided for the perpetration. The instigator is liable within the limits of his intention regardless of the responsibility of the direct perpetrator.
