

Penalty

An ailment specified by law for a legal entity being a sanction for non-compliance with legal norms. Criminal penalty – a consequence of committing a crime, which is an ailment defined by criminal law and in which disapproval of the act and the perpetrator is expressed. Criminal penalties are: - fine, - restriction of liberty, - imprisonment, - 25 years of imprisonment, - life imprisonment, - military arrest, - death penalty (not in force in Poland). Criminal penalties are imposed only by the courts.
