

## **Prison Court**

A division of the regional court, which has the power to adjudicate over convicted persons. In cases reserved for the penitentiary court in the district of the convicted person in the district of the penitentiary penitentiary code, the competent court for the penitentiary court is the penitentiary court. The penitentiary court decides on: - resolving doubts as to the execution of the decision or the calculation of the penalty; - discontinuation of enforcement proceedings; - suspension of enforcement proceedings; - repeal or amend a previous decision; - admitting a trustworthy person to participate in the proceedings before the penitentiary court as a representative of the convicted person during a session of the penitentiary court. The remaining part of the court's jurisdiction concerns only the prerogatives of this court (listed in the Executive Penal Code).
