Victim

A person whose legal interest, such as life, health, property, honour, has been directly violated or threatened by a crime. This role can be played by a natural or legal person, as well as a state, local government or social institution, even if it does not have legal personality. The aggrieved party is a party to the proceedings, which means that he has the right to: - familiarize himself with the content of the files with the consent of the person conducting the proceedings; - file motions for evidence and be present at them; - appeal against the decisions of the authority conducting the proceedings.
